<b>Results</b>	<p>The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions Aussie Skate, Preliminary and above.</p> <p>Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.</p>
<b>Event Officials</b>	<p>Judge/s, Technical Controller and/or Technical Specialist and Data Operator/Video Replay Operator for any scheduled events are by invitation.</p>
<b>Membership Requirements</b>	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and WAFSC.</p> <p>(Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™ and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate™</p>
<b>Insurance/Liability</b>	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA &amp; WAFSC assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
<b>Eligibility to Compete</b>	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p> <p>Aussie Skate refer: <a href="#">ISA Communication101</a></p>

<b>Entry Conditions</b>	Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Full Payment paid on entry</li><li>○ Music File - submitted to be received on entry or before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019</li><li>○ Planned Program Content Sheet (PPC) for all IJS-level programs to be received on entry or before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019</li><li>○ * Late entries will not be accepted</li></ul>
<b>Divisions</b>	Singles: Aussie Skate Level 4, Preliminary, Elementary, Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Intermediate, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior
<b>Withdrawals</b>	Refund only with a medical certificate provided <b><u>before the draw.</u></b> <b>No refund permitted after the draw.</b> <b>A 50% to cover costs may be deducted from the refund.</b>
<b>Conditions for Online Entry</b>	All state associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the state association and an affiliated club.

If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete.</p> <p>All files must be submitted in the following format: mP3/Wav/m4a (as decided by LOC)</p> <p>Standard File Naming: Division_Segment_Name_RunTime</p> <p><b>IJS Technical</b></p> <p>e.g. ElementaryMen_FS_DavidSmith_2m3s  e.g. AdvNovDance_FD_JaneSmith_JohnDavis_3m10s  e.g. JuniorLadies_SP_JaneSmith_2m45s</p>
<p><b>Other Music file notes</b></p>	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD (or other device e.g. USB as permitted).</p> <p><b>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</b></p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>
