Results	<p>The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions Aussie Skate, Preliminary and above.</p> <p>Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.</p>
Event Officials	<p>Judges: Each member state of Ice Skating Australia may nominate up to 1 judge to the event. The judge must be a minimum of ISA Senior Singles Judge. Nomination of the judge must be received by the 1st of June 2021 28th September 2021, in writing to wafsc@outlook.com.</p> <p>The LOC will cover the accomodation cost of ONE nominated judge from each member state from the 2nd July 2021 – 4th July 2021 29th October 2021 - 1st November 2021.</p> <p>Any additional judges nominated will be at the cost of the individual/ member state.</p> <p>Officials: Referee, Technical Controller and/or Technical Specialist and Data Operator/Video Replay Operator for any scheduled events are by invitation.</p> <p>The LOC will cover the accomodation and travel cost of invited officials from the 2nd July 2021 – 4th July 2021 29th October 2021 - 1st November 2021.</p>

(Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™ and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate™</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>Club members are members as at the 1st May 2021.</p>
Insurance/Liability	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA & WAFSC assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA & WAFSC recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
Eligibility to Compete	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p> <p>Aussie Skate refer: ISA Communication101</p>
Practice Sessions	<p>Official Practice session will be provided for all ISA Benchmark Events ONLY, Basic Novice to Senior.</p> <p>Other divisions may be offered practices at an additional cost subject to space available.</p>
